MCCHORD THRIFT SHOP SPOUSE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND APPLICATION

The McChord Thrift Shop is pleased to announce that they will give scholarship awards to eligible US Armed Forces dependent spouses. These awards will be presented on a non-discriminatory basis without regard to race, creed, sex, national origin, or religious affiliation.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. These awards will be offered to legal dependent spouses of:
 - a. Active-duty Air Force, Army, Marine Corp, Navy, or Coast Guard personnel stationed in the local area or on assignment to any unaccompanied remote tour where the family resides in the local area*
 - b. Retired Air Force, Army, Marine Corp, Navy, or Coast Guard personnel residing in the local area*
 - c. Deceased Air Force, Army, Marine Corp, Navy, or Coast Guard personnel whose family resides in the local area*
 - d. Air Force, Army, Marine Corp, Navy, or Coast Guard reservists and National Guard assigned to Joint Base Lewis-McChord
- 2. The applicant must have a high school diploma, G.E.D. certificate or a recent college transcript with a GPA of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale.
- 3. The applicant must be enrolled during the academic year 2024-2025 in a prescribed course of study geared toward degree completion.
- 4. Spouses may reapply for our scholarships as many times as they like. However, an individual will NOT be awarded scholarship money from this organization more than ONCE.
- 5. Applicants who have previously submitted application packages must re-submit all required information.

*Local area is defined as up to and including the area within a 50-mile radius of the main gate of McChord Field located at Fairway Road, McChord AFB, Joint Base Lewis McChord, WA 98438.Applicants must be authorized dependent privileges and possess a valid dependent ID card.

SPOUSE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

The merit awards will be awarded to applicants on a ranked scale. The number and amount of awards will be determined by the MTS Scholarship Committee. The monetary awards are funded by the McChord Thrift Shop.

Award recipients will be recognized by the McChord Thrift Shop in spring/summer following awarding.

All information given by the applicant is confidential. Names of applicants will not be known to the evaluation team. The evaluation team is an independent committee of members of the community not associated with the McChord Thrift Shop. Their decisions are final.

LIMITATIONS:

No award will be given to a student accepting a service academy appointment, a 4-year ROTC scholarship, or a full scholarship (room, board, & tuition).

Awards will be paid directly to the school in which the winner enrolls, upon receipt of **enrollment verification**. **Enrollment verification** will be the official document provided by the school with recipient's enrollment information. Screen shots, photographs, or emails are NOT official enrollment documents and will NOT be accepted as such.

The scholarship will be used for tuition & fees, and only for the student named in the award. Awards must be used in the 2024-2025 academic year. If the student does not complete at least one official term of school, for any reason other than hardship (to be determined by the MTS Board), he/she will ensure the return of the full amount of the MTS award within 60 days of dis-enrolling.

Each scholarship award recipient and his or her sponsor will be required to sign a contract accepting the rules and regulations of the Spouse Scholarship prior to the disbursement of funds. Recipients are responsible to provide the official school address for where checks will be mailed.

DEADLINE:

COMPLETED TYPED APPLICATIONS, AS WELL AS ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION, MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN APRIL 15, 2024 TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ANY AWARD.
